

CODE OF CONDUCT




- Members should use the Code of Conduct to guide service and actions while on the Local Planning Committee



The Village of Lyons Falls is located at the confluence of the Moose and Black Rivers. The center of the village is at the junction of Route 12 and Route 12D. Most of the commercial development is limited to McAlpine Street and Center Street (which turns into Franklin Street).
